
Sometime in 1910, Albert is diagnosed with Pulmonary Tuberculosis.

After the divorce, the 1911 Seattle Directory shows Albert living at 1608 38th Av N. A few lines below, Elvine is listed as "widow", still residing at the 2436 E. Aloha address (although Albert was clearly not dead at that time). The 1912 directory shows Albert residing at 1114 3rd Av, which according to Seattle city map of that period was a hotel in "downtown" Seattle. Albert died at the Firlands Sanitorium (located north of Seattle) on January 15, 1913 (age 40) from Pulmonary Tuberculosis.

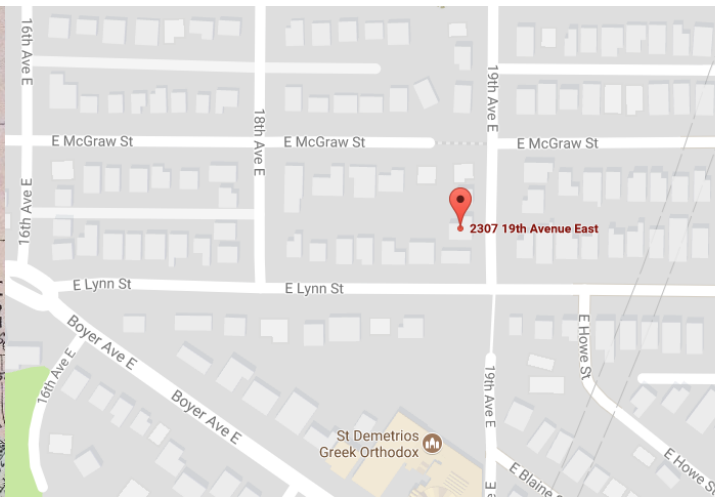

In 1911, Firland Sanatorium began accepting patients suffering from highly infectious tuberculosis (TB). The hospital's country setting in Richmond Highlands, well north of Seattle, isolated patients from the healthy populace and provided the fresh air which doctors considered essential. In 1948, Firland housed nearly 1,050 patients. It closed in 1968 after new antibiotic treatments allowed patients to live at home.



1921 Jun 1 - Letter

On June 1, 1921, Inga Groset née Hustøft, the wife of John Groset (married August 30, 1919 in Chicago), Roy's step-father then residing in Chicago, wrote a letter to her parents in Norway. (Note that the language spoken in the Oppdal region through the early 1900s is Oppdaling, a sub-dialect of Trøndersk, itself a dialect of Norwegian, so some words in this letter are spelled differently than modern Norwegian). Inga refers to Roy by first name only, which implies that there have been previous letters to her parents about him. The letter is four pages; only the relevant portion is included here.


In the letter, Inga writes...

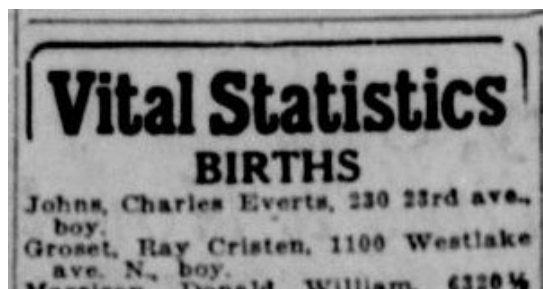

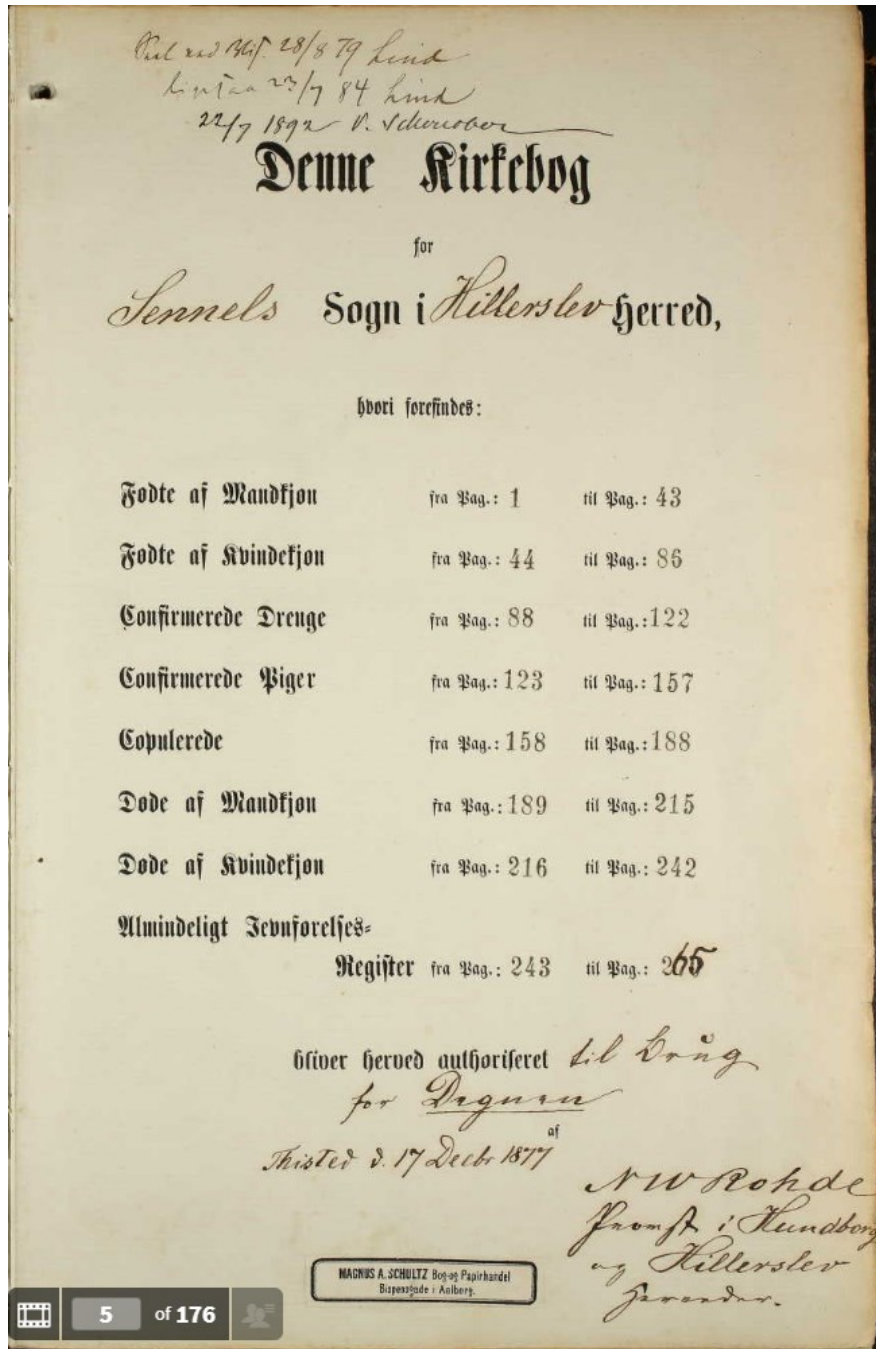

This could be for her departure from England – it was common for immigrants to sail from mainland Europe to England, and from there board an oceanliner bound for the United States or Canada. But there is no "proof" or corroborating/supporting evidence that this is the same person, except for similarity of name and age.

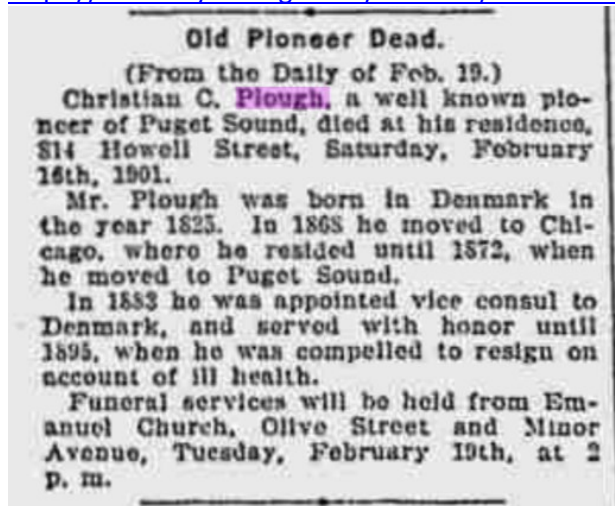
